Must take **end of course exams** in Algebra I and Geometry or Integrated Math I & II

Physical Science

American History & American Govt

English I and II



And must have **1 of 3**:

- cumulative passing score on seven end of course exams (TBD)
 - earn a “Remediation Free” score on a nationally recognized college admission exam (ACT/SAT) State will pay for all 11th grade students to take the exam FREE 1ce
 - Earn a State BOE approved industry recognized or state issued license for practice in a career and achieve a score that demonstrates workforce readiness & employability on a job skills assessment
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Comprehensive Alignment Process

1. learn new standards (take each standard and deconstruct it for skills & rigor)
2. understand 8 instructional shifts embedded in stds (how teaching must change)
3. Look at PARCC assessment prototypes
4. Conduct Gap Analysis
5. Create curriculum maps and align lessons
6. Select resources

Ohio Next Gen Assessments:

Science: (school year 2014-15)
Grades 5 & 8
HS End of Course: Bio & Phys Sci

HS End of Course: Am Hist, Am. Govt

PARCC Performance based assessment (taken at 75% through school year)

read and *analyze* texts worth reading

write in response to text dependent questions

PARCC End of Year Assessment (taken at 90% through school year)

measures *reading* literature/informational text & vocab interpretation and use stds

PARCC Speaking & Listening (required 2015-16)

2 types:

Real Time Engagement (grades 3, 5, 7, 11)

listen to prerecorded speech or media production

spontaneous oral responses to questions/topics

Advanced Preparation (grades 4, 6, 8, 10, 12)

conduct research of authentic topic in advance

share findings in formal presentation

respond spontaneously to audience questions

ELA Go To Words: Complexity, Evidence & Knowledge

Three types of items on PARCC tests

1. EBSR: Evidence Based Selected Response
2. TECR: Technology Enhanced Constructed Response
3. PCR: Prose Constructed Response (full essay)
